Other Business (NEW BUSINESS)

Budget 2025: The 2025 budget has been turned into finance for approval.

Proposed legislation in MI: Two bills relating to waste and recycling are in the works in Michigan. One is Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) and the other is increasing the landfill tip fee from \$.36 to \$5. DPW staff is staying in the loop on the progress of both of these bills.
